

ROYAL DECREE

No. 73 / 2023

Assigning the Competencies Related to Contract Review

To the General Secretariat of the Tenders ~~Board~~Council Transferred from the Ministry
of Justice and Legal Affairs

We, Haitham bin Tarik, _____ Sultan of Oman,

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After perusal the Basic Statute of the State,

And the State Administrative Apparatus System issued by Royal Decree No. 75 / 2020,

And Royal Decree No. 84 / 2020 regarding the General Secretariat of the Tenders
~~Council~~Board

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And Royal Decree No. 88 / 2020 merging the Ministry of Justice and the Ministry of Legal
Affairs into one ministry called the Ministry of Justice and Legal Affairs and determining its
competencies and approving its organizational structure,

And in pursuance of the public interest,

Have decreed as follows

Article (1)

The following competencies related to contract review are assigned to the General Secretariat
of the Tenders ~~Council~~Board, transferred from the Ministry of Justice and Legal Affairs, as
follows:

1. Reviewing of draft unified model contracts prepared by the units of the State
Administrative Apparatus and other public corporate persons in cases stipulated by law.

2. Reviewing draft contracts exceeding the value of (5) five million Omani Rials, and the variation orders related to them, regardless of their value, before their signing and the commencement of their implementation by any unit of the State Administrative Apparatus or other public corporate persons. The review, for non-unified model contracts, includes the pre-contracting procedures.

Article (2)

The technical members and legal advisors in the Ministry of Justice and Legal Affairs concerned with contract review, and other employees of the Ministry whose work is related to that review, shall be transferred to the General Secretariat of the Tenders Board, with their same seniorities and financial grades, and they shall retain on a personal basis the allowances they receive that are linked to the nature of their current functions.

The transfer of the aforementioned shall be in accordance with the mechanism agreed upon between the Minister of Justice and Legal Affairs and the Secretary-General of the Tenders Board.

Article (3)

All that is contrary to, or in conflict with, the provisions of this Decree shall be repealed.

Article (4)

This decree shall be published in the Official Gazette and shall come into force on the date of its issuance.
